UPDATE ON CORONAVIRUS HEALTH & SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

The Mt. Calvary Revival Center (MCRC) seeks to be a proactive congregation and community partner in mitigating exposure and spread of the coronavirus/COVID-19 in our area. In an effort to inform MCRC members and friends of our continued efforts to ensure the health and safety of our congregation, please be aware of the following:

CURRENT STATUS & PROCEDURES

- There are NO reported cases of the coronavirus infection among our church staff or congregation.
- MCRC maintenance staff conducts regular cleanings of our Worship Center, meeting rooms, and restrooms throughout the week prior to and after events and meetings. The staff utilizes industry-standard cleaning tools, instruments, and disinfectants.
- All MCRC restrooms are equipped with soap dispensers and paper towels.
- MCRC is currently supplied with multiple bottles of hand sanitizer for member and guest use.

UPGRADED PROTOCOL & MEASURES

- ALL MCRC REGULAR WORSHIP ACTIVITIES (Sunday Worship Service, Thursday Evening Service, Funerals and Weddings) WILL CONTINUE AS SCHEDULED, until advised otherwise from city and/or state government officials.
- MCRC has prioritized maintaining its Sunday worship services. We will continue to conduct two worship services on Sunday at 9 am, and 11:30 am with continued live streaming via YouTube, Facebook Live and mcRevivalCenter.org.
- Regularly scheduled meetings and rehearsals will also continue as scheduled, until advised otherwise from city and/or state government officials.
- The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention has recommended avoiding close contact, and we ask that you minimize/refrain hugs, kissing, and handshakes. During fellowship time at worship services, please only wave and greet your neighbors from a distance.
- MCRC is working with our Calvary Cleaners team, which will conduct an additional disinfectant cleaning all of the facilities, vans and busses to ensure optimal health conditions.
- MCRC will continue to restock hand sanitizer as necessary throughout our facility.

HOW CAN YOU HELP?

If you are displaying any symptoms of a cold, flu or virus of ANY FORM:

- We ask that you NOT enter the church facility until you recover from any and all symptoms through the full 14-day CDC advised self-quarantine period; this includes ALL members, ministry leaders, guests and church staff.
- We ask that you take the necessary health precautions and contact your doctor for advisement.
- We ask that you thoroughly wash your hands for twenty seconds using disinfectant soap each and every time you wash.
- We ask that you cough into your elbow to reduce the spread of potential bacteria in all settings.
- We ask that you visit The Center for Disease Control and Prevention for further prevention measures you can take to protect you and your family: www.cdc.gov/coronavirus.

WE ALSO ASK THAT YOU

- PRAY for our world, our leaders, and health professionals, as well as the most vulnerable among us.
- SHARE this information with other MCRC members.
- CONTINUE to attend worship services regularly if you are healthy and able to do so.
- LOOK for regular church updates via MCRC Realm, social media, and email.
- CONTINUE TO REGULARLY SUPPORT MCRC FINANCIALLY through your consistent giving of tithes and offerings through use of your giving envelopes, Cash app (\$Revival392), and the Giveifly app, both of which can be downloaded from the app store of your digital device.
- CONTACT THE CHURCH OFFICE at info@mcRevivalCenter.org and let our church staff know if you have contracted coronavirus/COVID-19.
